#### THE ROAD TO ST. LOUIS

- •This year's six teams that advanced to the National Invitational include four automatic qualifiers, one at-large bid, and one host berth earned by Missouri Baptist. The auto qualifiers were awarded to teams that won their respective conference tournament.
- •Because Missouri Baptist won the South Conference Tournament, the automatic bid turned into an at-large bid.
- •Each of the six teams will play three games in pool play at the National Invitational
- •Two of the six teams are returning to the invitational from 2014.
- •Only one of the teams in this year's field have won the National Invitaional.

#### NATIONAL INVITATIONAL BY THE NUMBERS

- •This year marks the 16th National Invitational since 1999.
- •Former member California Baptist has won the most National Invitationals with eight. Park University's four are the second most titles won.
- •There have been 22 schools that have qualified for the NAIA Men's Volleyball National Invitational since 1999.
- •Park University holds the record for the NAIA National Invitational appearances (since 1999) with 14.
- •Former member California Baptist is the only school in NAIA history (since 1999) to have four consecutive invitational wins. No other team has won the invitational more that one year in a row (since 1999).
- •Davenport, lowa, has seen the most invitational tournametrs with five: 1999, 2003, 2010, 2011, 2012
- •Cardinal Stritch has not been to the National Invitational since 2010

- This is the first year that the National Invitational is being held in St. Louis.
- •The closest the invitational has been to St. Louis is St. Charles, Mo.
- •This is the first year that Missouri Baptist has hosted the National Invitational

# **National Invitational Preview**

#### 2015 NAIA National Invitational Tournament Field Set

ST. LOUIS, Mo. – The 2015 NAIA Men's Volleyball National Invitational Tournament Championship presented by Tachikara field of six teams is set, as host institution Missouri Baptist has earned the No. 1 overall seed after winning the 2015 NAIA South Conference Tournament Championship on Saturday.

The Spartans will host the National Invitational on Apr. 23-25 inside the Carl & Delores Petty Sports and Recreation Complex in St. Louis, Mo.

Defending national champion Park University (Mo.) will serve as the No. 2 seed. The Pirates earned the first of two at-large bids and are in search of its fifth NAIA Men's Volleyball national championship as they won in 2003, 2008, 2012 and 2014.

Park is 25-4 on the year, while MBU enters the tournament with a record of 25-8 and defeated Park in the NAIA South Conference Tournament on Saturday on the Pirates' home floor.

NAIA North Conference Tournament champion St. Ambrose (lowa) is this year's No. 3 seed. The Bees defeated Grand View (lowa) in four sets on Saturday to earn the NAIA North automatic bid (23-25, 18-25, 25-20, 23-21.). They last competed on the national stage in 2013 and played in the national championship match in 2011 and 2012.

No. 4 seeded Grand View earned the second at-large bid into the national tournament, as they finished as the NAIA North Conference tournament runner-up. This is the second-straight national tournament appearance for the Vikings.

No. 5 seeded Hope International won the NAIA National Conference Tournament in Merced, Calif., on Saturday, as the Royals won three-straight matches over Warner (Fla.) Concordia-Irvine (Calif.) and University of California-Merced. This is the first appearance in the national tournament since 2012 for the Royals.

The final spot goes to No. 6 seeded Cardinal Stritch University (Wisc.). The Wolves won the 2015 NAIA Great Lakes tournament championship on Mar. 28 in a four set win over then-No. 6 ranked Lourdes University (25-23, 25-17, 19-25, 25-23). This marks the first time since 2010, the Wolves have qualified for the national tournament.



# MBU/Park Volleyball Rivalry May be Best in NAIA

**ST. LOUIS** – Over the course of the years, as schools come and go from the NAIA, one constant has remained. In both men's and women's volleyball, there may be no better rivalry going that of Park (Mo.) and Missouri Baptist.

A rivalry fueled by controversy, thrilling wins and crushing defeat has built over the last several years as both programs have come to the forefront of the NAIA. Now, with the number one and two ranked teams heading into the National Invitational, the prohibitive favorites may do battle one last time in 2015 with title hopes on the line.

After the dust settled from the NAIA South Tournament Championship, Missouri Baptist holds the edge with a 2-1 record against the Pirates this season. On the women's side, it was a clean sweep for Park as the team from Parkville captured its first NAIA National Championship with an undefeated season.



Yes, the rivalry has continued and escalated over the years. The Pirate women won a national title, but MBU finished fifth in the nation. Now, as the defending National Champions look forward to a shot at its second-consecutive championship on the men's side, they may have to do it against that same Missouri Baptist squad it has battled year in and year out.

Each point between these two opponents have been hard-fought and sometimes mired in controversy. Whereas in many situations a "bad call" may be briefly acknowledged by coaches and players, in this rivalry, those calls seem to filter their way into the overall landscape of the match.


Players shouting the occasional jab across the net in-between points are not uncommon as the coaches on both benches carry the same competitive nature. Adding to it this year, Mike Talamantes, Head Coach at Park University, and John Yehling, Head Coach at Missouri Baptist, split the NAIA South Coach of the Year Honor. The two have been


coaching on opposite sides of the scorers' table for four years and both seem to be a little extra animated when they meet in competition.

More is on the line when these teams play. Blocks are more celebrated; kills are more exciting, and every point more important than the next.

In 2012, as Missouri Baptist hosted the MAMVIC West Tournament in the newly-opened Carl and Deloris Petty Sports and Recreation Complex, one of the seminal moments of this rivalry occurred.

During play in the semifinal game between Park and Missouri Baptist, a security alarm began to sound throughout the gym. As Missouri Baptist personnel worked to rectify the situation, the Spartans and Pirates played through the intermittent alarm until MBU tookdown the higher-seeded Pirates and headed to the conference title game and a berth to the National Invitational.





If these two teams face-off in the National Invitational, it would not be until the semifinals, at the earliest. With a championship on the line, it could make for a heart-pounding show-stopper the likes of which will provide bragging rights for the winner and a crushing defeat for the loser.

On paper, Missouri Baptist's numbers are better when facing the Pirates. Mico Janicijevic is averaging 4.4 kills per game and has a .316 attack percentage against Park in three matches. Kyle Foley is averaging just short of 12 assists per set as well.

Park's Daniel Arteaga leads the team with 40 kills in three matches against the Spartans, but is hitting just .237. Milos Trivunic is averaging 10.3 assists per set. Both have numbers that are solid, but for both categories, Missouri Baptist has the edge.

What it will all come down to, however, is who will dig deep enough and put it on the line. Who wants it more.

As with any good rivalry, you can throw-out the record books and the statistics. All that matters is what is left out on the court. With these two competitors, it is a good bet that the match will be a thriller from start to finish.
